

Winterbourne Parish Council Policy on Use of Glebe Hall Car Park

Winterbourne Parish Council maintains the car park adjacent to the Glebe Hall, Vicarage Lane, Winterbourne Earls, Salisbury. SP4 6HA. The car park is leased by Winterbourne Parish Council from Salisbury Diocese.

CCTV cameras are positioned to overlook the car park and in the event of criminal behaviour footage will be passed to the Police for further investigation, in accordance with the Parish Council's CCTV Policy.

The car park is for the sole use of the following:

- Hirers of Winterbourne Glebe Hall
- Staff of the Kindred Bourne Valley Nursery School (BVNS), in accordance with the agreement between BVNS and Winterbourne Parish Council
- Attendees of BVNS being dropped off or picked up (under the same agreement)
- Attendees of St. Michael's Church

The following rules apply:

- Disabled parking spaces are for Blue Badge holders attending events at the Glebe Hall
- There should be no overnight parking, unless at the specific permission of Winterbourne Parish Council
- There should be no joyriding
- Cars should be sensibly parked in three rows running parallel to the long side of the Glebe Hall
- Cars exiting Vicarage Lane on to the A338 should give priority to cars entering Vicarage Lane from the A338
- There should be no commercial or trade activity

In the event of maintenance works Winterbourne Parish Council reserves the right to close the car park to all users.

Winterbourne Parish Council reserves the right to control access at any time.
